Community Foundation Offering Funding Opportunities to Local Faith-Based Organizations

LANSING, MICH. — An open call to any faith-based organization in Ingham, Clinton or Eaton County: the <u>Community Foundation</u> is offering 10 grants to help support their charitable projects. Organizations can apply from now until July 1, 2019.

Each grant awarded offers \$500 to fund a project that addresses a community need. These grants support charitable initiatives of faith-based organizations that benefit a community as a whole, beyond any one religion. Since 1997, the Foundation has granted over \$91,000 to 326 faith-based organizations in the capital region.

Projects ineligible for funding are: building funds, faith-formation activities or programs requiring anything in return from those it benefits.
