COMMUNITY FOUNDATION SEEKS GRANT APPLICATIONS FROM TRI-COUNTY FAITH-BASED ORGANIZATIONS

LANSING, MICH. – The Community Foundation is seeking grant applications from faith-based organizations (FBOs) in Ingham, Clinton and Eaton counties for charitable work benefiting the community. Projects such as food banks, clothing distribution, after-school programs and assisting the needy will be considered for funding. Capital projects are not eligible for grants, and these funds are not available for faith formation programs.

Ten grants of up to \$500 each will be awarded by the end of July, and all applications are to be postmarked no later than Friday, June 1, 2018.
